

We believe the next generation will save Haiti.


Every child should get to go to school. The Student Sponsorship program supports the students and the school.

81% of Funding Sent in 2025

The school also uses a portion of this funding for salaries, operating expenses, and fuel for the school bus.

Empower the next generation of Haiti to break the cycle.



Ewo works directly with the school to determine needs that might benefit from targeted fundraising efforts. In 2025, Ewo Sponsors and Donors supported two major fundraisers. Back to School focused on school supplies and Giving Tuesday efforts allowed Campus Improvements for each of the four ICB School locations.

HOW WE SUCCEED


Make HEROES in Haiti through education.
